Sub-committee	New subcommittee members serve a minimum of three (3) years for their first
Terms	term due to the first year they participate as trainees.
	All current sub-committee members serve a minimum two (2) year term and are

	eligible for reappointment until they choose to resign from their position. Terms run May to April. The Chair and Vice Chair each serve a two-year term.
Selection/ Appointment	New subcommittee members are identified through a call for faculty. A selection committee made up of current members is created and selections are based on application review and candidate interviews. Members are appointed by the President with input from the Chair. The Committee Chair and/or Vice Chair is recommended by the outgoing Chair and appointed by the President.
