

## Ethics Sub-committee Charter Document

Purpose Ongoing Sub- committee Activities / Charges & Strategies	<ul> <li>The Ethics Subcommittee is dedicated to enhancing the quality of life and well- being of patients and residents in the various post-acute and long-term care settings. We advocate for the PALTC community through collaborative efforts and educational initiatives and strive to ensure that ethical best practices are being considered.</li> <li>The sub-committee undertakes the following activities: <ul> <li>Develop educational presentations for the Society that focus on ethical issues in PALTC.</li> <li>Enhance the Society's online educational materials with a focus on ethical topics in PALTC.</li> <li>Contribute articles that are ethics-based to <i>Caring for the Ages</i> and <i>JAMDA</i>.</li> <li>Interact with the larger organization to provide ethical feedback and insights when needed</li> <li>Be available for AMDA members to discuss or address ethical issues/concerns if they arise</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
Roles and Responsibilities	<ul> <li>Chair</li> <li>Help structure agenda for meetings.</li> <li>Run an effective meeting to ensure involvement of members and the advancement of activities and charges.</li> <li>Communication with the Board liaison before and after each Board meeting to share updates from the Sub-committee and to hear about new Board initiatives. Report back to the full Sub-committee on each discussion with the Board liaison.</li> <li>Identify, mentor, and groom the next Chair.</li> <li>Assist with structure and selection of members.</li> <li>Vice Chair</li> <li>Support the Chair to ensure responsibilities are met in a timely manner.</li> <li>Serve as interim Chair in the absence of the Chair.</li> <li>Ascend to the position of Chair.</li> <li>Members</li> <li>Be prepared and actively participate in all conference calls and meetings.</li> <li>Work on projects as delegated by the Chair or Vice Chair.</li> </ul>
Expected Commitment	The committee meets quarterly via conference call. Members are expected to review all agenda/materials prior to each meeting, attend the conference calls as scheduled. The estimated monthly time commitment is 1-5 hours.

Sub-committee Composition	The Ethics Sub-committee is comprised of interested medical directors, physicians, and nurses, or Members of AMDA/PALTC who demonstrate an interest in ethics. This may include Medical Directors and physicians.
Sub-committee Terms	All sub-committee members serve a two (2) year term and are eligible for reappointment once. Terms run May to April. The Chair and Vice Chair each serve a two-year term and can be in addition to their previous 2 membership terms.
Selection/ Appointment	Members are appointed by the President with input from the Chair. The Committee Chair and/or Vice Chair is recommended by the outgoing Chair and appointed by the President.
Sub-committee Requirements	<ul> <li>Members:</li> <li>Express desire to serve with a special interest in ethical issues and best practices concerning the quality of care delivered to patients in post-acute and long-term care settings</li> <li>Desire to advance the mission of AMDA.</li> <li>Ability to make the necessary time commitment.</li> <li>Must be a Society member in good standing.</li> <li>Must disclose all financial relationships on an annual basis.</li> <li>Ability to attend and actively participate in conference calls.</li> </ul> Chair: <ul> <li>In addition to the above requirements, when possible, the Chair should have previously served as the Vice Chair.</li> </ul> Vice Chair: <ul> <li>In addition to the above requirements, when possible, the Vice Chair should have previously served as a member.</li> </ul>
